Fees

Applicants are required to pay a €50 non-refundable registration fee on acceptance of an offer of a place.

At the start of the course students will be required to pay €500 if not a medical card holder a this is made up of a €80 equipment cost which will include 2 mannequin heads and uniform shirt (these items will become your personal property); a € 50 hairdressing consumables contribution fee; €20 student services charge €150 City and Guilds registration fee and log book and a €200 DES contribution charge. If you are a medical card holder you will be required to pay €300 as medical card holders are exempt from the DES contribution charge. There is also a €10 fee for each online test (12 in total).
