This has been a very successful year for our school. All made possible by the hard work and dedication of our whole school community, students, teachers, special needs assistants, PLC tutors, secretaries, caretakers and cleaners. Each member of our staff is enabled to reach their potential due to the support and vision of our Board of Management.

Teaching and Learning: This year saw the beginning of a collaboration with Carrick on Shannon Community School in the area of building learning power. Under the guidance of educationalist Graham Powell, staff from both schools began coaching each other in the area of building learning power. We hope to extend this further next year and through true collaboration we hope to bring learning to an even higher level in St. Louis. As part of our School Self Evaluation this year each teacher explored the area of active teaching methodologies, strategies and student engagement which has been very well received and appreciated by the students in our school. The introduction of the one hour timetable has helped embed active teaching methodologies and has received almost universal approval from staff, students and parents. 15 teachers have now completed the Instructional leadership (12 day programme) which will further enhance the learning experience in St. Louis.

Student learning and academic achievement flourish in a safe caring environment and I know that is what St. Louis Community School offers. Our Pastoral Care team meet in a voluntary capacity one day a week, and our SEN department ensures that the student most in need of resources gets them. Our staff of dedicated teachers continue to develop their skills as teachers and in addition volunteer so much of their time to provide extra-curricular activities.
