

Third Green Flag for St. Louis.

The St Louis Students have shown excellent initiative over the past number of years, since becoming part of the Green Schools Ireland Programme, under the direction and co-ordination of Ms. Geraldine Molloy and Ms. Christine Gormally.

The school has been awarded flags for Litter and Waste management and energy conservation. Their efforts are ongoing however, as they have recently been awarded their third green flag for Water Conservation, with a massive saving of 31%, 436 units over the last year.

The flag was awarded after a visit from Mayo County Council Environmental Officer, Laura Henehan who was very impressed with the St. Louis School and their performance to date.

Two students will be selected to represent the school at a Presentation where they will receive the flag at an award ceremony and the flag raising celebration will take place at St. Louis in September 2015.

The students and staff of St. Louis will continue to work effortlessly as over the next two years they will be working on the Transport theme along with maintaining the other completed teams of Litter and waste management and the conservation of water and energy.
