What is Leaving Certificate Applied?





- It is a distinct, self-contained two-year Leaving Certificate programme aimed at preparing students for adult and working life.
- It emphasises forms of achievement and excellence which the established Leaving Certificate has not recognised in the past.







Who would benefit most?

- Students who are not adequately catered for by other Leaving Certificate programmes.
- Students who choose not to opt for those programmes.





Rationale





- Prepares students for adult and working life
- Recognises talents of all pupils
- Promotes communication and decision making skills
- Applies knowledge and skills to the solution of real problems

Leaving Certificate Applied Qualification



Certificate awarded at three levels:

Pass 60-69 % (120 - 139 credits)

Merit 70-84 % (140 - 169 credits)

Distinction 85-100 % (170 - 200 credits)

Leaving Certificate Applied and the Local Community



Learning in Leaving Certificate Applied involves students in many out-of-school activities including:


