Principal's report for the school year 2015-16



Summarising the happenings in our school this year, I am filled with a sense of pride modified by humility at having the privilege to work as Principal in such a vibrant, caring, progressive, innovative and, most importantly, happy school.

The work and dedication of the staff to the holistic education of the students in our school is truly remarkable. When I say staff I mean everyone that works in this school, teachers, special needs assistants, secretaries, caretakers and cleaners.
